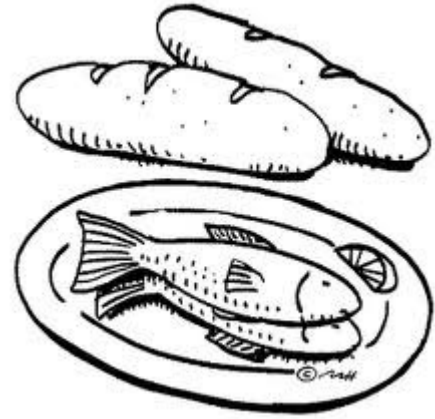


# Unit 5: "The Boy's Lunch"

## (Feeding the 5000)








**Bible Story Reference:** John 6:1-14

**Bible Verse:** "There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish. But what are they among so many people?" (John 6:9)

**Main Idea:** Jesus accepted a boy's simple, yet generous gift of two fish and five loaves of bread. Jesus blessed this gift and turned it into a feast for more than five thousand people.

**Objectives:** Children will explore the following concepts:

- God sent Jesus to teach people more about God and what God calls them to be and do.
- Jesus fed a large crowd of more than 5,000 people when a boy shared his lunch of five loaves and two small fish.
- Through this act, Jesus helped the people understand how powerful God really is and how God truly cared for their needs.
- The stories of Jesus' miracles are part of the mystery of faith.
- We can care for people by sharing food and other resources.
- God can multiply what we do
