# A Variety of Opportunities to Volunteer with Foodshare!

Foodshare's vision is for a community where all people can get all of the food they need. As the region's food bank, they work toward that vision by getting food donations from the food industry and distributing them to 300 food pantries, community kitchens, homeless shelters and other partner programs. There are **three ways to get involved** with Foodshare here at First Church.

- 1. Volunteer when the Mobile Foodshare truck comes to our back parking lot every other Wednesday morning at 10:00 a.m. This is a "farmer's market" style food distribution of fresh produce and other foods, and it takes many volunteers to serve everyone who comes. If you are interested in participating (adults, youth and children are welcome!), contact Sally Riddell at 860-657-8715.
- 2. Volunteer at Foodshare's Regional Market in Hartford on "When hunger stops, so will we." alternating Wednesday mornings to help sort and package the produce that gets given out on the Mobile Foodshare truck at various sites across the state.
